Competition Rules

The ACT Junior/Senior/Masters 2.5/3.5/5/7.5 km Cross Country Ski Championships has 2 categories of racing which is determined by the race license class of the race entrant.

Championship Race:

Open to all registered SSA International, National and Junior (U20) Sports Class competitors.

Note:

Sports Class (Junior U20 and below) are eligible to compete in the Championship Race and are eligible for National and State rankings or National and State team selection.

Sports Class Race:

Open to all SSA registered Sports Class skiers. Sports Class competitors will be listed in a separate race result.

Note:

- Sports Class (Junior U20 and below) are eligible to compete and receive a result in the Championship Class (as detailed above).
- Sports Class competitors (Open and Masters) are ineligible for the Open Championship results, National and State rankings or National and State team selection.
- Sports Class (Master U40 and above) skiers are eligible for Championship Class Age results however they are not eligible for Open Championship results.

Notes for Junior Skiers

- Junior Boys Under 18 and Under 20 (who both ski 7.5 km) will be automatically entered in the Senior men championship event (who also ski 7.5 km) and thus could be both the overall junior boys champion and the overall senior men champion for that event.
- Junior Girls Under 16, Under 18 and Under 20 (who all ski 5 km) will be automatically entered in the Senior Women championship event (who also ski 5 km) and thus could be both the overall junior girl champion and the overall senior women champion for that event.
